1. Click on the cover of an item you want to borrow.
2. Click on the **three dot icon**.



3. If the item is available, click **Borrow with OverDrive**.
4. The item will automatically be checked out to you.

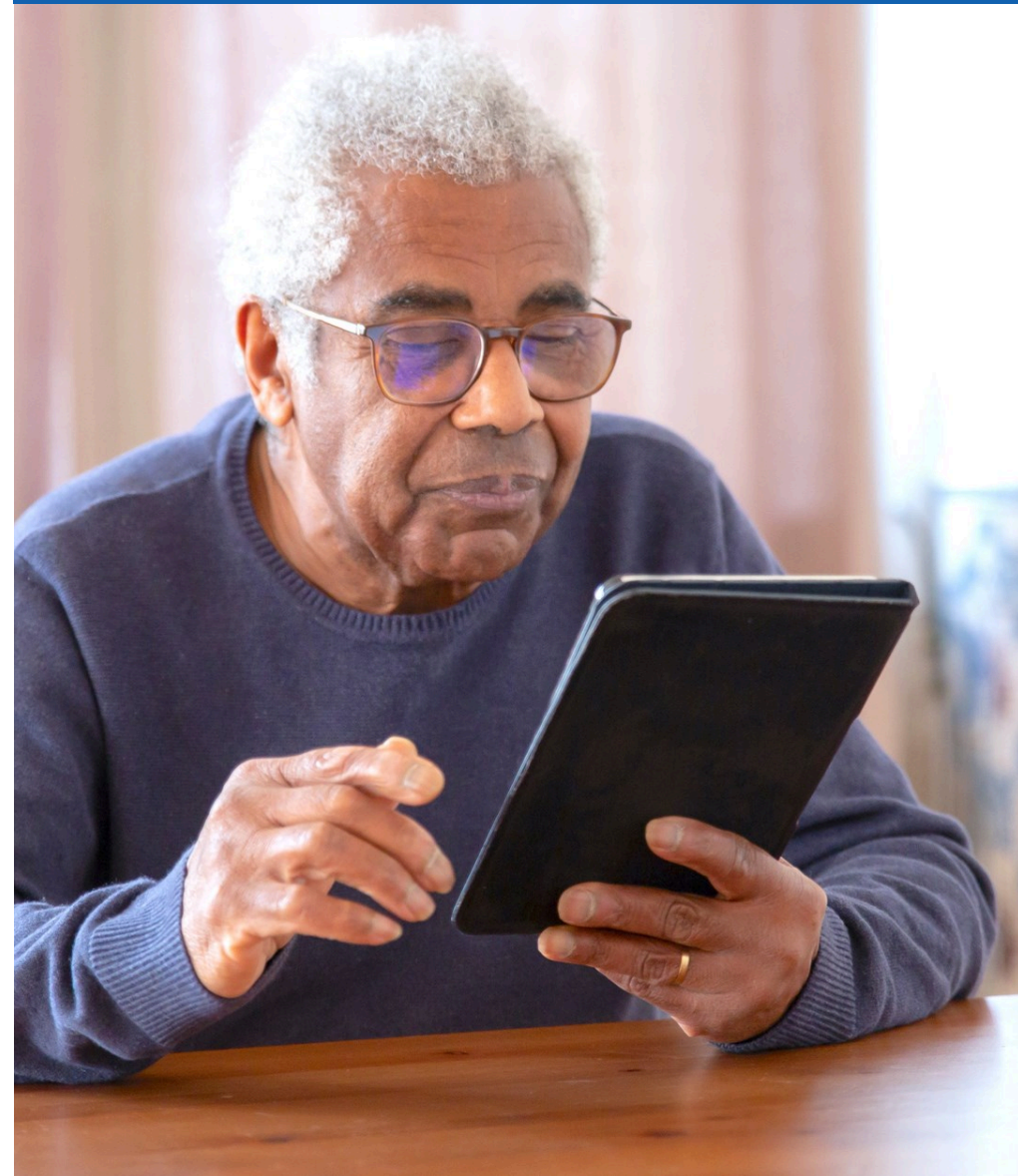

▶ Kobo's with Built In OverDrive

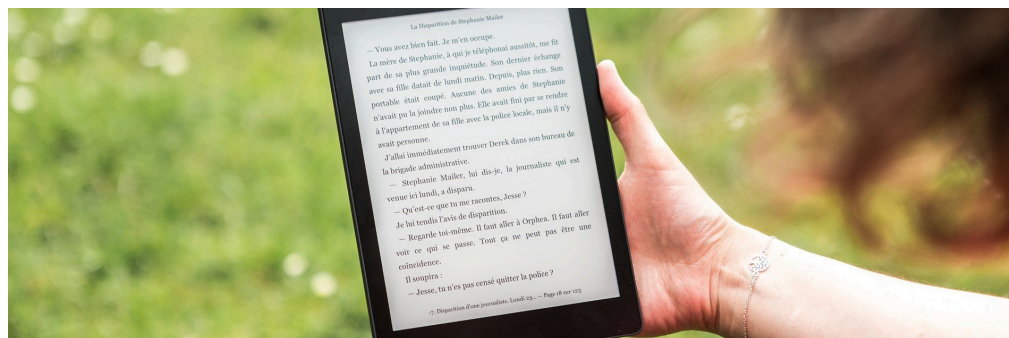

▶ Logging In

1. Click on **More** at the bottom of the screen and select **Settings**.
2. Under **Settings**, click on **OverDrive**.
3. You will be taken to the OverDrive account page, click **Get Started**.
4. Start typing the name of your home library and click on it when it appears.
5. Select **TRAC Consortium**.
6. Login with your **library card barcode number** and **PIN number** (if you do not know your **PIN number**, contact your local library).
7. Click **Sign In** and you are ready to go.



▶ Searching

To search for eBooks, click the **Discover** tab at the bottom of the screen. Click on the **magnifying glass** to search for titles, authors, and more.

Some Kobo eReaders have an **OverDrive** option at the top of the **Discover** tab screen. This will limit your search to only OverDrive items

▶ Placing Holds

1. Click on the cover of an item you want to borrow.
2. Click on the **three dot icon**.



3. If the item is unavailable, click **Place a Hold with OverDrive**.
4. Confirm you want to place a hold by clicking **Yes**. You will be notified when your hold is available to borrow.

Check your holds by clicking **Discover > OverDrive > Your Holds**.
